



The Magical Harry Potter Experience

July 28 – August 5, 2020

For those of us who never received our Hogwarts letter at 11, this is the trip of a lifetime. See where Harry, Ron and Hermione ran away from Death Eaters, the trio got their first flying lesson, and the winding streets of Edinburgh where JK Rowling got her inspiration for Diagon Alley.

Day 1: Tuesday, July 28 - USA - London

Day 2: Wednesday, July 29 - Day at leisure

Arrive in London and drop your bags off at the hotel. Spend the day familiarizing yourself with the wonderful city of London.

Accommodation: Ibis Styles London Kensington or something similar

Day 3: Thursday, July 30 - Harry Potter Film Walking Tour

Meals: breakfast

After breakfast, we will meet in the lobby of the hotel to begin our Harry Potter walking tour. We'll begin at Leadenhall Market where they filmed the Leaky Cauldron scene in Sorcerer's Stone before heading across the bridge that was destroyed by Death Eaters in Half Blood Prince. On the other side of the bridge, we'll walk to Australia House, the real Gringotts Wizarding Bank and No. 12 Grimmauld Place—home of Sirius Black and the Headquarters of the Order of the Phoenix. Afterwards, we'll explore the tube station Harry and Mr. Weasley took to get to the Ministry of Magic before heading to King's Cross Station to try our luck at passing the wall between platforms 9 and 10.

Day 4: Friday, July 31 - Harry Potter Studio Tour

Meals: breakfast

In the morning, we'll take the Harry Potter bus to Watford to begin our Harry Potter Studio Tour. Explore the magical set of Harry Potter with a guided tour. See the Great Hall of Hogwarts, fly on your very own broomstick, see all the costumes from all eight movies and the practical effects and behind-the-scenes peeks at one of the most magical series of all time.

Day 5: Saturday, August 1 - Day trip to Oxford

Meals: breakfast

Follow in the footsteps of Harry Potter, Ron Weasley, Hermione Granger and other characters from the Harry Potter movies and look inside New College and Christchurch Harry Potter film site. New College is said to be haunted, so if you're lucky you may see more than just talking pictures and floating lamps in its medieval Hogwarts-style dining hall. Christchurch staircase and cloister are where Harry and Co. ran up the ever-changing staircases to escape Filch's cat, Mrs. Norris, before discovering the three-headed dog, Fluffy! Pretend you're in Hogwarts as we explore these iconic sites.

Day 6: Sunday, August 2 - Train to Edinburgh

Meals: breakfast

After breakfast, we will head to the train station to take the train to Edinburgh. This is the same route Rowling took to Edinburgh when she thought of the infamous Harry Potter. When we arrive, you'll have the rest of the day at leisure.


